Can they remember the <b>song</b> and <b>action</b> that goes with the sound?</li> <li>5. <b>Can they find any objects at home beginning with /u/ for our 'Sound Sill' in the classroom?</b> (Objects will be returned on Friday!)</li> </ol> <p><i>'u/-u/ up go umbrellas, /u/-u/ up go umbrellas, /u/-u/ up go umbrellas... ...when it starts to rain!'</i></p> <p><b>Tune:</b> Skip to My Lou <b>Action:</b> keep one hand steady and raise the other, as if putting up an umbrella, and say u, u, u, u!</p>
