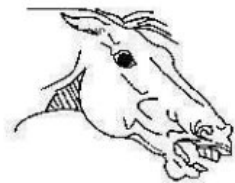
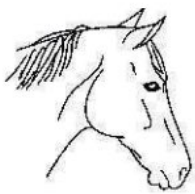

b. Meet Sid. Mark on Sid with a X or ✓ where it is safe and unsafe to approach a horse? Give a reason for your answer.

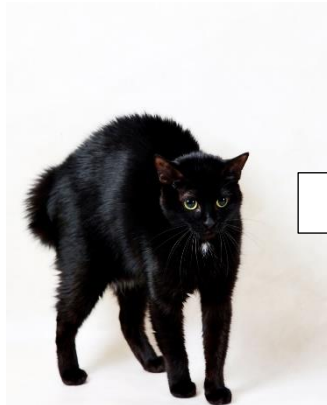

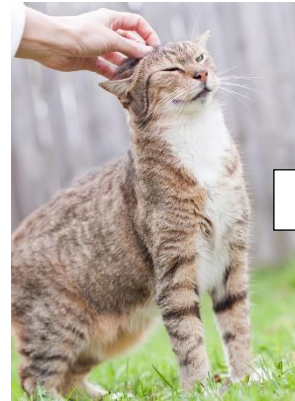
